In 1972 Otl Aicher engaged local craftsmen to construct wooden table ensembles according to his own designs for the "rotisserie", his vaulted canteen and banqueting hall in the newly acquired Aicher domicile Rotismühle.

Aicher sat at these tables with his staff, his guests and sometimes with his family. At lunch, at meetings, at parties. And namely: Otl Aicher, Inge Aicher-Scholl, Josef Bitz, Florian Aicher, Hedwig Maeser, Norman Foster, Willi Daume, Hans-Joachim Friedrichs, Julian Aicher, Sissi Gräfin von Schweinitz, Peter Schubert, Manuel Aicher, Hans-Peter Dürr, Johannes Rau ...

Julian Aicher still owns two of these table segments.
